Characteristics of the Qualification Module	
Aims	The course is addressed to the municipal technical offices in order to give them suggestions and help as entities in charge to manage the administrative procedures concerning in particular with the energy aspects of the buildings renovation and as owners and managers, in many cases, of a building stock usually very consumptive and often traditional.
Methodic Approach	The module is organized as a front class lecture with slides presented by the speakers, with a duration of 4 hours with a short break in the middle. The meeting is held in a conference room. The participants were supposed to ask questions during the open discussion foreseen at the end of the meeting, but questions, observations and objections are possible even during the presentations in order to better understand and appreciate the presented issues. A folder with AlpHouse brochure as well as the training program is distributed to all the participants. In the folder it's included also a 'satisfaction questionnaire' in order to let the attendants state their opinions about the contents dealt with and the used methodology, ask further clarifications and suggest subjects to deepen in next meetings. After the event all the presentations are available as files for the participants (via email or downloadable from a website) and to each of them a certificate of attendance to the training course is sent.
